


Population Trend in Egypt








Percentage growth in Sudanese refugee numbers versus all nationalities since the start of the crisis





As of January 1, 2023, the total number of Refugees and Asylum Seekers was 288,524

By Dec 2024, the estimated refugees and Asylum Seekers registered with UNHCR will reach 0.9M






Age and Gender Breakdown


- Sudanese became largest refugee population at the end of October 2023
- Currently, an estimated 30-80 K unregistered in Aswan


Refugees & Asylum Seekers Onward Movement Tracking
